In fact, many centuries before Europe, India had a prime meridian of its own. It was called madhya rekhā (or ‘middle line’) and passed through the city of Ujjayini (today Ujjain), which was a reputed centre for astronomy over many centuries. Varāhamihira, a famous astronomer, lived and worked there some 1,500 years ago. Indian astronomers were aware of concepts of latitude and longitude, including the need for a zero or prime meridian. The Ujjayinī meridian became a reference for calculations in all Indian astronomical texts. a. Name the longitude which was taken as Prime Meridian of ancient India. Madhya Rekha (Ujjayini) b.
