5.02.22	<p>Basant Panchami</p> <p>Vasant Panchami, sometimes referred to as Basant Panchami or Shree Panchami, is a Hindu festival celebrating Saraswati, the goddess of knowledge, music and art. It is celebrated every year on the fifth day of the Indian month Magh (January-February), the first day of spring. Traditionally during this festival children are taught to write their first words. Also known as Saraswati Puja, this festival is celebrated in Nepal, India and Bangladesh to invoke wisdom and consciousness in human beings.</p> <p><u>Class I and II</u> Children will learn to make Origami Swan. Link will be provided to them.</p> <p><u>Class III and IV</u> Children will make beautiful paper roses. Link will be provided to them.</p> <p><u>Class V</u> Children will make Paper Tree Wall Hanging. Link will be provided to them.</p>	<p>White or Sky blue Origami paper</p> <p>A few colored A4 size sheets</p> <p>An old cardboard (approx. 24cmx27cm-size can vary as per choice) covered with sky blue paper, 2 Brown/ Black A4 papers, light pink paper(A4) pearls(optional), pink squares of paper, scissors, thread to hang</p>	<p>Children will learn about Basant Panchami and its significance. They will make beautiful flowers and swan(the vehicle of Goddess Saraswati) which will enhance their creativity and knowledge about the festival and Spring Season.</p>
