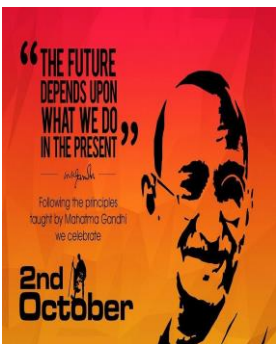

1st OCTOBER 2021 (Friday): GANDHI JAYANTI ASSEMBLY

He is known as the Father of the Nation by the Indian people because of the integral part he played in the Indian freedom struggle.
