

Our future generation needs to be sensitized towards their role in taking care of Mother Earth. In order to make children aware about their responsibility a show and tell activity on 'Best out of waste' has been planned for our little ones.

Best out of waste simply means to make something innovative and attractive from the material we do not use anymore. It is a straightforward process to REUSE, RECYCLE and REDUCE.
