AZADI KA AMRUT MAHOTSAV DOSEL- DOP 75 LAKH POST CARD CAMPAIGN

- ❖ In accordance with the **CBSE Circular 119 dated 24th November,2021**, as part of the ongoing celebrations of Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav (AKAM), the Department of Posts (DoP), Ministry of Communication, along with the Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Education, propose the '**75 Lakh Post Card Campaign**'.

THE DETAILS OF THE PROGRAMME

1. DATES OF THE CAMPAIGN

1st December till 20th December, 2021.

2. PARTICIPATION

Students of classes 4th to 8th can participate in the Campaign.

3. HOW TO COLLECT THE POST CARDS?

❖ **CLASS 4**

Interested students can collect the Post Cards (Hard Copy) from their respective Class teachers in school, during the school hours on **1st December, 2021**.

❖ **CLASS 5**

Interested students can collect the Post Cards (Hard Copy) from their respective Class teachers in school, during the school hours on **7thDecember, 2021**.

❖ **CLASS 6-8**

Interested students can collect the Post Cards (Hard Copy) from their respective Social Science teachers (Class 6&7) & History Teachers (Class 8) in school, during the regular teaching period, from **1st December- 10th December,2021**.

4. STEPS TO FOLLOW FOR WRITING THE POST CARD

- ✓ The students shall write a Post Card on **any of the two topics** –
 - “Unsung Heroes of Freedom Struggle”**
 - “My vision for India in 2047”**.
- ✓ The Post Cards shall be addressed to Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, South Block, New Delhi–110011.

5. RETURNING OF THE POST CARDS

❖ CLASS 4

Post completion the students will hand over the completed post cards to their respective Class Teachers on **1st December,2021**.

❖ CLASS 5

Post completion the students will hand over the completed post cards to their respective Class Teachers on **7th December,2021**.

❖ CLASS 6-8

Post completion the students will hand over the completed post cards to their respective Social Science teachers (Class 6&7) and History teachers (Class 8) during the regular teaching period, by **15th December,2021**.

Submissions made later than that will not be accepted.

6. EVALUATION & RESULTS

- ✓ Best post cards shall be selected from the CBSE Regions for the National Level Evaluation. These shall then be evaluated collectively with the best post cards received from the States and UTs.
- ✓ At the National Level, 75 best post cards will be selected. The list of 75 entries will be forwarded to DoP for participation in the final event to be held in the third or fourth week of January, 2022.
